Changing interpretations

Since the 13th century to 2012 messianic prophecy has been heavily scrutinized, rejected and questioned amongst many in the Jewish community (1). However one sudden change of Messianic interpretation furthered with the Jewish scholar known to many Jewish people as Rashi (2). According to past traditional methods of biblical Jewish interpretation ancient Rabbis before Rashi, and sources such as the Midrash, the Talmud and other such resources supported and interpreted many of the messianic prophecies as pertaining to a Jewish Messiah (3). Now since after Rashi's influence many modern rabbinic thinkers and commentators all seem to follow his model of misinforming or changing the scripture to fit a past historic or over literal approach to misinterpreting messianic prophecy (4). So what's wrong with this? By using Rashi's method to interpret certain messianic passages it either detours the reader's attention to focus on a past person of scripture, or reinterprets it as belonging to something else other than a Jewish Messiah.....
