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
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This month's encouragement is all about moving on. A New Year for some could mean taking a new direction or starting something new. In all cases moving on from the past could be spiritually healthy and can promote fruitfulness. However in order to reach a new direction we must learn to let go or forget about the past or stop moving into the same old, same old. The apostle rabbi Sha'ul mentioned that we all have better goals in the Messiah to reach, but yet again he reminds us to let go of the past and to press forward to the true prize (a). Moving on into a New Year also means that we have a great opportunity to improve on the things that held us back from growing and experiencing the fullness of the Messiah. A biblical application on the life of Avraham demonstrates to us that when G-d spoke to him to pick up and move on, that is exactly what he did. He did not hesitate to follow the G-d of Israel (b). Hesitation and looking for the past can distract us even cause us to miss the direction that G-d is calling us to enter into. Moving on when G-d calls us to is being obedient. Many Christians who fail to move on when G-d calls also wonder why their lives at times never seem to change or improve in this area. Change and improvement can be good for all of us especially if it's going to Glorify G-d. We need not fear moving on into the will and plan of G-d. 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**Who is the 4<sup>th</sup> Kingdom in Daniel 2:40?**

When we review the book of Daniel (1) we hear of a fourth kingdom which is strong as iron. It is a kingdom which also will eventually be broken into pieces (2). But the mysterious question here is who this kingdom is? Some have supposed or have interpreted that it is a Muslim or Islamic nation, or is the Kingdom of the Messiah. But that hardly seems to fit the traditional interpretation which heavily supports the idea that the fourth Kingdom is no doubt the Roman revived empire or as some would even call the one world government in which the Anti-messiah is ruler of. While there are so many factors of interpretation at work here there is a logical answer to this biblical question. First let's clearly submit that the fourth kingdom cannot be the Kingdom of the Messiah because this kingdom will be broken or crushed into pieces by the Messiah's coming and the setting up of his Kingdom (3). Next it cannot be an Islamic or Muslim nation because the Muslims or Islamic government will be no issue during the timing of the Anti-messiah's rule or after the return of the Messiah. In fact it's the Anti-messiah who will subdue 10 nations under him (4) and none of those nations involve or mentions it being Islamic in identity. So as far I understand Islam is not in the ball game. To suggest or imply that they are specifically mentioned in Daniel 2:40 is a bit out there and is a bit speculative. Modern day thinkers really do need to reevaluate their position on end time events. Though we may see the Islamic extremist growing to some level in our age it does not mean that they are the direct fulfillers of Daniel 2:40. Especially if there are no other biblical indicators which support that view to start with. The fourth kingdom is the Roman Empire or Rome revived headed up by the Anti-messiah in the soon days to come.

### Jordan: Roadside Bomb Against Israel Embassy Staff, None Hurt

Unknown terrorists set off a roadside bomb Thursday against a convoy of cars carrying Israeli diplomats in Jordan. No one was hurt. The diplomats were on their way to the Allenby Bridge from Amman, Jordan. The bomb went off at about 5:00 PM as a car carrying three Israeli diplomats passed it. No one was hurt. Two cars reportedly overturned as a result of the blast, however. The Israeli Ambassador to Jordan was not in the convoy that came under attack. The convoy reportedly continued to drive toward Israel and the Jordan Police launched an investigation. In 2002, Jordanian police said they had prevented an attempt by terrorists to enter the neighborhood of Amman where the Israeli embassy resides. The police said that they had arrested several suspects who possessed automatic weapons, hand grenades, handguns, knives and other weapons. In February 2008, gunmen attacked the Israeli embassy in the Mauritanian capital Nouakchott. Five people were injured in the attack, including one foreign national.

Our Hebrew word "kingdom-Mamlakah" this month draws our attention to the book of Daniel. In Daniels book we find a combination of both the Hebrew and Aramaic language.
