Was Isaac or Ishmael the sacrifice of Gen 22?

According to today's Muslims our portion of B'reysheet 22 (1) which reveals a historic account of the Sacrifice or binfding of Isaac (often called the Akidah) is really all about his son Ishmael. They also make claim that in every place where Isaac's name is written within B'reysheet 22 is replaced by the original name of Ishmael (2). In other words our ancient transcribers are accused here of deliberately voiding Ishmaels name and again replacing it with Isaacs instead. This weak but yet preposterous argument really shows at what great lengths the Muslims will take in discrediting the true account of the written scriptures. They also add that even a Jewish traditionalist whom converted to Islam say that Caliph Omar Ibn 'Abd al-Aziz (717-20s) that the Jews were well informed that Ishmael was the one who was bound, but that they concealed this out of jealousy(3).
