*Abiding in the
Messiah*

In this month of July, we may be hearing the message “abide in me” (Yohanen 15:4-5). But what does it really take to abide in the messiah? Does it take a surrendering of our life, or time? Does it require more of a commitment to Messiah or require forsaking things that occupy our lives? According to messiah’s statement found in (Yohanen-John 15:4-5) says that unless his followers learned to abide in him they could not bare fourth fruit. Baring fourth fruit is the evidence that we are abiding in the messiah’s teaching. The lesson of Yohanen goes on to tell us that applying the words, which are the teachings of the messiah, is how followers abide in him. If we walk or live contrary to the teaching of our messiah then we are not abiding or our we living in HIM. Even though we may have the spirit of G-d in us we have a choice to live in the root or outside the root. Living in or abiding in messiah means living and abiding in what the messiah says (Yohanen 15:7). When we abide in his ways the fruit is evident in our lives, ministries, etc, but those who don’t follow nor obey the teachings of messiah are like dry branches, which are broken off the tree and are used for the fire (Yohanen-John 15:6). In other words there are consequences for those who choose to live and teach contrary to the truth. It is quite easy to lose your way or to get sideswiped. Following errant messages or errant teachers can blindingly lead us out of abiding in the truth of the messiah’s teachings. Not every teaching, prophetic lesson, or so called spiritual movements verify its from the teachings of the messiah. We are told to test all things, spirits, teachings and to clearly “SEE” if they are of G-d (1Yohanen-John 4:1) before we allow ourselves to be subject to them. In this month let us focus more on abiding in the teachings of the messiah’s words. By abiding in his words we will be strengthen and will bare the fruit that shows we are walking properly with our G-d and Lord.

This Month’s Hebrew word is:

דָּבַק Da’Vak (Abide)

Which definition means: to cling, stick, stay close, cleave, keep close, follow closely, join to,

In the B’rit ha dasha (NC) it is written;

(Yohanen-John 15:10)

10 If you are a Shomer (keeper) of my mitzvot (commandments), you will Da’vak (abide) in my ahavah (love), even as I have kept the mitzvot (commandments) of Avi (my father), and I remain in His ahavah (love). 11 These things I have spoken unto you that my Simcha (joy) may remain in you, and that your Simcha (Joy) may be made sh’leimah (complete-full).

Here Yeshua rebbinu (Jesus our teacher) instructs his talmadim (disciples) on how to **Da’vak** (abide) in the fathers love. In order to abide, cling, follow and stay close within the love of the Father we must learn to be keepers of the commandments of G-d. By staying close to his commands we are “kept safe”. But if we fail to do or apply the words of G-d to our lives we are subject to falling outside of G-ds love and joy. Being and abiding in G-ds love means following and applying what he has taught us in his commandments. By living in his commandments one is full with G-ds joy. As Yeshua told his talmadim (disciples) the key to having and keeping G-ds love and joy is by simply learning to live in G-ds commands. Lets all learn to stay closer to the Messiah by applying G-ds commands to our lives. Lets make a point of being determined to be full with G-ds love and joy.



Israeli attacks claim 7 lives JUNE, 2007

GAZA • Israel killed seven Palestinians in two air strikes in Gaza yesterday, including three senior Islamic Jihad militants and a rocket manufacturer for an armed wing of Western-backed President Mahmoud Abbas's Fatah group. Israel's attacks aimed at tightening its military pressure on the Hamas-ruled territory it wants to isolate, came three days after an offensive in which 12 Palestinians were killed in the coastal territory. An Israeli military spokesman confirmed two aerial attacks in Gaza, including one that targeted a car of Gaza militants and in past attacks against Israel. Palestinian security sources and witnesses said the three militants killed in the first strike in the town of Khan Younis were commanders of the Islamic Jihad group in Gaza. The militants were identified as Raed and Zeyad Ghannam and Mohamed Al Rai.



Midrash with the Rav *Is there such a thing as a new Anointing?*

In our last months midrash (commentary) we covered what the anointing was from both the Old Testament perspective and B'rit ha dasha (NC) perspective. So now we will discuss the issue and question about, is there a new anointing? From the biblical perspective the answer is "NO." from the spiritual perspective which is tied to the biblical the answer is still "NO." Then how do we answer or respond when we hear that G-d is giving the body or individuals a new anointing? First lets listen to the statements themselves "**your going to get a new anointing,**" or **G-d is saying your going to get a new anointing or there's a new anointing coming**". As we mentioned from our study there is only "ONE" anointing and he is clearly called the Ruach ha kodesh (Holy spirit) (1Yohanan- John 2:27). To say ignorantly or to say G-d is saying or to make such statements as mentioned is to say that the Holy spirit is not good enough so G-ds people need a replacement or whole new one in general. This is absolutely absurd and is quite scary seeing that people are uninformed about this issue. Believers need to understand that

the gift of the indwelling spirit is for eternity. He does not need to be replaced, nor do we need a new one in order to fulfill G-ds will in our lives. The biblical fact and truth is that G-d will never replace his precious gift of the Holy Spirit, nor will he take him away from us (Rom 11:29). The one time empowerment or indwelling of the Ruach ha kodesh is utmost sufficient once and for all time. Even Yeshua said to his talmadim regarding this point. Yeshua rebbinnu (Jesus our teacher) said;

(Yohanan-John 14:17) Even the Ruach Ha Emet, (spirit of truth) which the Olam Hazeh (world) is not able to receive, because it does not see Him nor have da'at (knowledge) of Him. But you have da'at (knowledge) of Him, because He (the Holy spirit) remains with you and He will be in you (Acts 1:8)

Yeshua is clear in his instruction. There is only "ONE" Holy Spirit (Eph 4:4) who is also called the "spirit of truth" and there are not many spirits of G-ds truth but only the ONE revealer called the Holy Spirit. Let us now be assured that there will never be another (1Cor 12:13). For if there ever is another it will be of false origins (2 Cor 11:4). For the anointing (Holy spirit) from G-d is not separated from the tri-unity, nor is he one above G-d. He is ONE in and with G-d.
