### The Ten Mitzvah'ot (commandments)

In the Torah we find that the Ten Commandments were first written by the finger of G-d (1). These commandments are revealed in detail in the book of She'mot- (Exodus) (2), but was that all there was on the two tablets? Those who are not familiar with the Torah (3) here really miss the entire picture. Apparently the Ten Commandments not only were written on the two tablets of stone, but also on the other side of them as well. We learn all of this from the Exodus account (4). No one can say for certain what was on the other side, other than perhaps the full meaning or explanation of all Ten Commandments. When looking at many portrayals and pictures of the Ten Commandments today all we really see is the list of the Ten, but again where's the rest of it? According to the scripture those original stones were broken (5) yet we are told they are remade but nothing is mentioned about the rest of the content. Later we find that an additional book of writings from Moses is made and set next to the Ark of the Covenant (6). Could this book be the additional explanations for the Ten Commandments?

## MIDRASH WITH THE RABBI

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### Hated by all Nations!

Inspirational Reading

In this month we review what Mattiyahu-(Matt. 24:9) says "You shall be hated by all nations for my names sake". This statement made by our Messiah has to do with the first half of the 7yr. tribulation. Some have compared this verse to belong to today's anti-Semitism and hatred for Israel. However the passage is not for the current events in question. Some preachers have even insisted that this passage refers to the common believer who will face persecution and hatred for their faith. Though we may see a uprising hatred toward Christianity these days, let's be blatantly clear in that (Matt.24:9) deals only with those saints who will live during the first half of the tribulation period (a), and not with the nation of Israel or today's Christians. We also find a few similar passages (b) in Mark and Luke regarding the hated issue. But there it must be understood that Yeshua is only dealing with current events which will proceed in the apostle's immediate days and not in ours nor in Israel's. Though modern day martyrs do exists in other countries today the passage is not about them. The problem is that many confuse all the foresaid passages not distinguishing the timing or the fulfilling of the events. Now that we have a clue here we should also take in mind about whose doing the persecuting and hatred of the trib saints. According to (c) book of revelation the trib saints are hated and are
