## Our G-d is a G-d of Order

In this month of June we are inspired with the following scripture; **(1Co 14:40) Let all things be done decently and in order.** This is the ending scripture for chapter 14:40 of 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians. But here Rav Shaul (Paul) in the entire chapter touches on the disharmony, confusion, jealousies, and pride in G-ds body, which some had because they thought they had possessed greater gifts making them greater in the church. As a result their immaturity caused much strife and divisions over the matter leaving G-ds church disorientated.

So Rav Sha'ul gives instruction that every gift of every person is to be in unity, and is to be set in order as G-d has called them, whether tongues, prophecy, teaching etc. However the chapter (1Co 13) before this explains the meaning for the use of all gifts. The motivation for all gifts in the body of Messiah is his LOVE! No matter what the gift, service, ministry or call is, without Messiahs true love it is void or is for nothing. G-d is NOT a G-d of confusion or of disorder, but is for peace.

Therefore let us seek to understand the words of the scriptures. The word order means: an arranging, a right order, something that is set right, a disposition of things that follow one after the other.

Make NO mistake a church body that does not follow the order of G-ds word is a church that is out of order. A church that demands its own law or usurps its own authority above G-ds word is also a church that is out of order. A church that doesn't recognize the order of G-d ways is a church which knows not the truth. If G-ds truth and love are absent then G-d too is absent from their midst. Or let me say it this way, G-d is hindered from doing his will in that churches midst. And in knowing this should we choose to stay in a church who persist in this matter? The choice is always ours, but from biblical standpoints we don't have to be committed to a church like this unless it recognizes were it is and repents and makes right with G-d on all counts. Why? Because G-d is a G-d of order, and if the order of G-d is compromised by ungodliness and sin how can the people there spiritually survive? They will be like the blind leading the blind, both eventually fall into the ditch.

Beloved ones remember G-d is a G-d of order! And if you find yourselves under the yoke of a disorderly church we encourage you to seek out what the scriptures have to say on this issue. Don't be fooled by outward appearances or mans promises, seek to know what G-d says and act on his words. And by following G-ds word may you find yourself pleasantly in order with our loving G-d.

## Monthly Hebraic Study

This Month's Hebrew word is:

בֵּית Bet- (House)

Which definition means: dwelling place, an abode, habitation, shelter, a household

**(1<sup>st</sup> Tim 3:15) but if I tarry long, that you may know how one's hit'nahagut (conduct) ought to be in the Bet Elohim (house of G-d), which is Adat ha El Chai (the Community of the Living G-d), ammud (the pillar) and yesod (foundation) of Ha Emet (the truth).**

In this passage Rav Sha'ul writes young timothy in regards to his coming for a visit. But he says, "If I tarry" which meant that if his timing may have been delayed timothy was to know how to conduct himself among the believing community which here is explained to be the congregation of G-d or the church. But why did Rav Sha'ul make the point of saying, timothy know how to behave while in the congregation? Was he immature? Was he a rebel? The point was simply that his witness as a leader was important to those he was called to serve among. Unfortunately as in his day as well as in ours there are always certain peoples who make it their job to look for fault or look to accuse, cause division or blame leaders they don't approve of. But to dispel their judgments and to end their controversies leaders are instructed to walk upright publicly and especially in the House of Elohim (G-d). Every leader who is called to serve in G-ds house has to first be tested before being a leader! Their personal lives as well as public MUST be parallel to scripture and be watched for a time before they can even serve or take any church position. Every detail and in every way they must behave and follow the guidelines of the bible and only the bible. When they have met all the biblical criteria then and only then may they be considered to be leaders in G-ds house! It's a shame and a dishonor to G-d when people in a church take it on themselves to be leaders who have no qualifications, education, and training or do they follow or behave in the way the bible instructs us too. These are NOT leaders! But are people who are in error and in their error they cause G-ds people to error also. It also dishonors G-d and his church when their witness is contrary to the word of G-d, yet they refuse to heed to the instruction of the bible and do things their way and NOT G-ds. Let's learn from the word of G-d on how to conduct our lives in front of G-d that our witness will be in right standing and will glorify our G-d and lead others to do the same.

### Is Babylon of the bible really modern day America?

Some suppose that the biblical prophecies that mention the name Babylon refer to modern day America. There are books, DVDs, and internet sites to interpret this and other ideas that tell believers to think that America is BABYLON! But can we really trust or rely on their opinions or views? Here are just a few reasons why we should not. (1.) First off it's important to know the difference between literal, figurative or (spiritually) and non-figurative when looking at bible prophecy. Some confuse, overlook or ignore these biblical methods and take everything at the figurative or over spiritual point of view and misinterpret the whole text or its meaning, and then add meanings of their own to support their ideas. But understanding how to look at bible prophecies such as this one from all points of view will help give us a better picture of who, what or what is Babylon. Starting with an example from (Rev 11:8) gives us a figurative or spiritual look at Sodom and Egypt. If we read this in the literal point of view we think right away that Jerusalem is being called a modern day Sodom and Egypt. But when we read it figuratively or understand what the spirit was pointing out is that Jerusalem was NOT or is not a literal modern day Sodom and Egypt at all. Instead the point is to understand that the sins of Jerusalem at that time were like those of Sodom which were sexual immorality. While the sin of Egypt was idol worship. So the figurative sense tells us about two of Jerusalem's sins that would be judged by G-d. Not

Only was this the sin then, but is also a future reference for the sins now or during the tribulation period. As the spirit sees into the days ahead he literally reveals the sin that will be found in Jerusalem and they will be judged for it. But Jerusalem is not modern day Babylon as some thought, or is it Sodom or Egypt literally today. (2.) There are three applications to which Babylon is identified. (click here ) Two of these Babylon's are literal places NOT spiritual. While the last one is a literal spiritual perversion of faith, government rulership or religion at that time. But when reading certain places in the bible which point out Babylon it NEVER says or is implied directly, literally, figuratively or even spiritually that these prophecies all have to be linked to modern day America. Try and remember to keep in mind folks that during the prophecies or in the book of Revelations the prophets had no clue that America had existed and that the prophecies were never addressing a far away (click here for more )

### Egyptian efforts to broker truce with Israel fruitless JUNE 2008

A Hamas spokesman said on Friday that Egypt's efforts to mediate a truce between Palestinian militant groups based in the Gaza Strip and Israel "are fruitless" due to Israeli rejection to end the blockade and open the border crossings. "Hamas presented all needed conveniences to render the truce efforts successful, but Israel is still delaying and rejecting the conditions (for reaching a truce)," Sami Abu Zuhri told a news conference in Gaza. Egypt has been mediating a six-month truce in Gaza between Israel and Gaza militants group, including Hamas and several minor militant groups. So far, nothing has been agreed upon between the two sides. Israel insisted the truce deal should include the issue of the captive Israeli corporal Gilad Shalit and be calm for calm before the Jewish state ends a tightened blockade it has imposed on Gaza since Hamas bloodily took over the coastal enclave last June.
