Revelation or Misinterpretation?

This month's letter is inspired by an incident that actually happened. One day while at a Christian service a young pastor stood at the pulpit and said, he had a revelation from the Holy Spirit. So he then turned to the scripture where it is mentioned about the Master (Messiah) needing the donkey for his service (1,-1a). In any case he then went on to exclaim that the revelation from the Holy Spirit was about Yeshua (Jesus) wanting to loose everyone like the donkey was loosed, so he could give them blessing and prosperity for their lack. Sadly everyone followed in praise, shouting and clapping for G-d to loose them so they could have prosperity. But we wondered didn't any one realize that they were already free in Messiah Yeshua (Jesus Christ)? Didn't they realize that being free in the Messiah had nothing whatsoever to do with financial prosperity? The point is the young pastor was misinterpreting the passage, and then sadly attributed it as a revelation from the Holy Spirit. Folks, the Holy Spirit does "NOT" misinterpret G-ds word (men do). In fact he's the helping force which leads men to right understanding concerning G-ds word (2). He will never misinform anyone with so called man conceived revelations. The point about revelation biblically is stemmed from the revelation of the word that has already been given to us by the prophets and apostles (3). 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MIDRASH WITH THE RABBI

What is the Cup of Trembling?

According to the prophet Zechariah (a1) Jerusalem will fall under serious attack in the days ahead. The mention of the Cup of trembling is a symbolic object representing G-d's wrath, judgment, displeasure, or chastisement (a2). The prophetic event of Zechariah finds the timing somewhere in the mid 3 ½ year period of the seven year tribulation. This is where the Anti- Messiah and the gentile nation's armies will seek to over throw Jerusalem. However this is not the battle of Gog and Magog as some may have thought it to be. This battle or overtaking of Jerusalem by the Anti-Messiah is reckoned by the term "the battle of Armageddon." In any case the Anti-Messiah and the nation's armies with him will take this cup of trembling; their fate ultimately in the end will be their own destruction for attacking G-d's land and our people (b). But what will also happen at this time is that Israel will defend itself and will not go down without a fight. G-d will empower his people to fight back, but they will loose the battle for the greater victory (c). Another thing to consider about this event is that G-d is behind the whole thing! It is he who makes the Anti-Messiah and his armies drink of the cup of trembling. The end result for our people will be safety from all enemies. This is mentioned in a number of messianic prophecies. One of the Messiahs task is to save our People as is found in Romans (d). So the plan for our people though it may have looked dark actually is for our people's survival and future restoration and blessing. All these things which will happen actually drive our people to calling upon Yeshua (Jesus) as Messiah. But it's important to know that it all really gets started with the cup of trembling.





This Month's Hebrew word is:

כוס Koes (*Cup*)

Which Hebrew definition means: *drinking vessel, basin, goblet, bowl,*

Study Portion Matt 26:27-28

Hebraic Commentary

In Mattiyahu (Matthew) the Messiah turns the traditional Passover **koes** (cup) into a symbol for the B'rit ha dasha (New covenant). Other past covenants sometimes had accompanying symbols such as like that of the rainbow which was symbolic for the Nohidaic covenant, and the sign of the Shabbat (Sabbath) for the Mosaic covenant. The B'rit ha dasha symbol is the Koes (cup). The cup that the Messiah used is also traditional in the weekly Sabbath meal. The head person of the Jewish home usually gives thanks at the dinner table. He says the traditional prayer blessing

Israel begins the biggest military drill in its history

OCCUPIED JERUSALEM: Israel began the biggest military drill in its history on Sunday, putting soldiers, emergency crews and civilians through rehearsals for the possibility of war at a time of rising tensions with Iran. The five-day drill, code-named Turning Point III, will include simulated rocket and missile attacks on Israeli cities and preparations for a nonconventional strike. Air-raid sirens are to sound across the country on Tuesday and for the first time, all Israeli civilians will be required to practice taking cover in shelters when the sirens go off. It is the third consecutive year that Israel is holding the exercise, a direct result of its 2006 war against Lebanon. During the conflict, Hizbullah fired nearly 4,000 rockets into Israel, and civil defense authorities, bomb shelters and air raid alarms were found to be unprepared. Iran's development of long-range missiles, along with Israel's fears that Iran is developing nuclear weapons, have added to Israeli jitters. Iran denies seeking atomic weapons and insists its nuclear program is aimed at generating electricity. Israeli leaders played down any connection between Iran and this week's exercise, and officials have tried to allay fears among Arab neighbors, such as Lebanon and Syria, that it could be a cover for a military strike (click for more)
