Lessons from G-d

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This month's encouragement is on learning lessons from G-d. Imagine living in a place where you have no rest or peace. Imagine that all your neighbors are disrespectful and seem to dislike you for no reason. They trouble and harassed you at night so you can't sleep, they fill your apartment full of cigarette smoke and they have an owner who does nothing to keep order or peace but themselves harass you also. You may ask what kind of place is this? and is there a lesson here for us to learn from G-d? Actually G-d uses circumstances to teach us about many things; however the enemy takes advantage of things also. But in biblical circumstances we learn that G-d teaches our enemies that He is in control of our lives and shows the enemies that they cannot utterly harm his people nor even take their lives from them. Such fact is found in the book of job (a). We also learn that G-d teaches his adversary (ha satan) that our G-d is a just G-d. No matter what may appear as a life tragedy always is turned around for our good. Another lesson that we can learn in situations like this is to endure hardships or persecutions (b). These are not always easy lessons to learn right away, but in the end believe it or not it is for our good. Pain, suffering and unhappiness is NOT a quick process to go through, but praise be to G-d- Adonai (the Lord)he will supply us a way to endure(c&c2). As we go on through life with our Messiah he will be sure to reward us when we are unjustly treated, suffer or are persecuted for his sake, and he will also reward those who have caused such treatment towards us as well(d). Take courage this month and know that G-ds lessons are always for our good.



Will the Jewish people be fooled by the anti-Christ?

Part II

As we touched last month on a few issues of the Anti-messiah we found that he wasn't Jewish at all, but in fact is going to be a gentile who arises out of the European area. We also found that the Hebrew text places the background of the anti-messiah as also being of gentile origins. Now this month let's finish our discussion on why the Jewish people won't be fooled or make the anti-messiah their personal messiah or savior. Naturally the scriptures do not teach that the anti-messiah must be Jewish. However Yeshua himself said beware of false messiahs. Meaning there will be many imposing the position of a messiah which will turn out to be false as we have seen over the years (a). Yeshua however never implies that the one main anti-messiah must be Jewish as Yeshua is and this is clear. He only says in scripture "when you therefore shall see the abomination of desolation" (b). Hinting absolutely of no physical origin; however the past prophecy of Daniel has spoken of a world figure called the little horn that stands and takes a position of a so called god or again viewed as a world leader (c). The scriptures never dictate or suggests that the Jewish people will instantly make him their personal Messiah or savior. Instead the scripture really formulates the idea of an allied who makes a false or faulty covenant with our Jewish nation for seven years. This scenario lays out the way for a pack between the newly founded allied and the Jewish nation. It's like America being an allied to Israel, though Israel has not made America its personal savior or messiah. It only accepts it as a supporting and protecting allied, nothing more, nothing less. This is the concept for the world leader. He's never accepted as a messiah but only as a political allied who then betrays and breaks his covenant agreement (d) with Israel in the middle of the seven years. In the three year point the Jewish people realize who it is they are dealing with and proceed to flee from him.

Third Attempt to Torpedo Jewish Housing in Yafo

A group of Arab and Jewish residents of Yafo, the Association for Civil Rights in Israel, and the Rabbis for Human Rights organization lost a second round in court last month while attempting to shut down a religious-Zionist housing project in Yafo. However, despite being ordered to pay four defendants 20,000 shekels each, the plaintiffs were not deterred, and have appealed a second time. Having lost in a local court and in the Tel Aviv District Court, they are now filing suit in the Supreme Court against B'Emunah, an organization that builds housing for the religious-Zionist community. The organization has several building projects in mixed Arab-Jewish cities in pre-1967 Israel, including the project in Yafo that is the subject the suit. The plaintiffs argue that the B'Emunah project is illegal, because the organization plans to build for religious-Zionist families and not others. Yisrael Ze'ira, head of B'Emunah, expressed disgust at the latest attempt to torpedo the project. "There's no limit to how far the post-Zionist Association for Civil Rights will go to try to drag this out," he said.
