According to a chapter in the book of Mattiyahu ⁽¹⁾ we read that the Tribes (translated as all the Nations of earth) will mourn when see the sign of the Ben Elohim (Son of Man) coming in the clouds. In the Tenach (OT) the clouds represented the great She'kinah or (the Glory presence) of G-d ⁽²⁾ However the Great She'kinah here is accompanied by the body of believers ⁽³⁾. The event spoken of here cannot be the catching away or (rapture) event as some would have supposed. The event here is most clearly the 2nd coming of the Messiah at which time he will come in great judgment and will fight and slay the wicked, ⁽⁴⁾ and will judge those nations which are left ⁽⁵⁾. It also should be realized that the fight which will take place in the future will be singlehandedly fought by the Messiah himself ⁽⁶⁾. The saints will only witness the great defeat, not aid the Messiah in the battle ⁽⁷⁾. In other words it's his fight and he alone will end it! But the world has no clue as to what lies ahead. Only that one day soon mourning over judgment will arrive on that day.
