In this months letter we would like to inform you about the issues of anti-Semitism (1) in the bible. Our first question begins with can we find traces of Anti-Semitism in the bible? Actually there are NO suggestions, statements or even attitudes of Anti-Semitism found within the B'rit ha dasha (New covenant) writings. However there are many teachers, pastors and lay people who ignorantly use the New Covenant writing in an Anti-Semitic way. Here's a great example. My wife and I were at teaching one day where the speaker was talking about a believer's identity. At first he began by saying the kingdom of G-d was made up of two people, them being of Jewish and then of gentile origin. Later he then quoted (2) Gal 3:28 saying the opposite. In other words he mistakenly used the statement from that scripture to imply that Jewish people mean nothing or are nothing in the Kingdom. The last time I read prophecy told me the kingdom of G-d would be restored back to our people (3a.b)! But his mistake of Gal 3:28 was used very anti-semantically whether he new it or not. But this type of teaching is found in many places where statements made by Sha'ul (Paul) are taken out of context. The ones often used in an anti-Semitic way are scriptures which pertain to "there are neither Jew or Gentile"(4a.b) but if we understand the true teaching of Rav Sha'ul we learn that all peoples being first the Jewish (5) and then gentiles have salvation and a place in G-ds kingdom through Messiah Yeshua. 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MIDRASH WITH THE RABBI

What are tongues? Part 2

In our last Midrash we touched a bit on the subject of "what are tongues". Here is the final conclusion. We start off with a question. (1) See scrip reff box for catch up last letter) How then from this did some Christians later come to the conclusion that tongues alone were not communicational only spiritual? Basically as we know the Pentecostal idea taught this traditional view to its main stream body and it has been accepted and encapsulated without through investigation or understanding. Listen folks Rav Sha'ul (Paul) was NOT dealing with some alien phenomenon of some unknown mystery language as some would claim. But as charismatic's and some Pentecostals assume from reading Jude 1:20 i.e. (2) that this validates one must pray in the Holy spirit. Praying in the Holy Spirit means praying in tongues or in your heavenly language. But the truth is that (Jude 1:20) in no way ever taught this idea. What he does manage to teach us from his Jewish understanding is that praying in or that is to say under the direction of the Ruach ha kodesh (holy spirit) clearly means praying under the influence, anointing or guidance of the spirit himself (3) Rom 8:26). This says or implicates nothing about tongues whatsoever! It should be realized at this point that a believer's empowerment comes none other than from the word of G-d and the spirit alone, not from praying in tongues. "Building up your holy most faith" means to discipline yourselves according to the word or doctrine of G-d which is holy, and because our holy faith is based according to it. Not according to tongues! Ten rockets hit southern Israel, one damages Ashkelon school

Ten rockets from the Gaza Strip struck Israel yesterday. Six targeted Gaza-area communities, two hit Ashkelon, one landed in the Eshkol district and one near Sdot Negev area, the Israel Defense Forces said. There were no casualties or property damage, with the exception of one rocket that struck an empty schoolyard in Ashkelon. The school was severely damaged, with shrapnel hitting some of the classrooms - including areas the Defense Ministry had defined as safe, Ashkelon municipal sources said. Deputy Mayor Shlomo Cohen slammed the "foot-dragging" in reinforcing the city's schools. "The school that was hit was classified by the Home Front Command and the Ashkelon municipality as unfortified, and we have been requesting that this school be given basic, inexpensive protection. The solutions offered were approved by both us and the Home Front Command, and have been lying on the desks of the Defense Ministry chiefs for two weeks now," Cohen said. Following the attack, Cohen met with the commander of the Home Front Command Southern (Click)
