*This months inspiration begins with the question, are your plans his plans? Sometimes we make so many plans for our lives, but often forget to seek G-d whether our plans fit his. Some make unrealistic goals and plans without counting the cost in advance. Others make absolutely no plans at all and find themselves missing G-ds direction in their lives, because they fail to seek G-d first. Then there are others who have mapped out their entire lives and when it doesn't flourish the way they had intended it to go they grow embittered and question, Why G-d? But looking and taking life from a biblical point of view we are reminded in Mishlei (1) that we alone are NOT to lean upon our own understanding to figure out all the plans of our lives. We are to always put all plans, situations, and direction in G-ds care. As we do this we wait for the answer. Some while waiting grow impatient, frustrated and get anxious about what to do or where to go (2). They often end up in the wrong place at the wrong time, and suffer the consequence because they choose to go their own way instead of waiting for G-ds way. The consequence being disappointment and feeling let down. But again are our plans really his plan? His plans lead us to blessing and fulfillment, but our plans without him lead us to places of hurt and discouragement. G-ds way is not always easy but the end result is always good because our G-d is good and knows what's best for our lives. ## MIDRASH WITH THE RABBI

### Are Jewish people blind because they read the Tanach (OT)?

Scripture Reference



In the B'rit ha dasha (NC) we find a passage in (2Cor 3:13-14(a) which basically says in the King James version that the Jewish people are blinded today because they still read the Tanach (Old testament). The Tanach is the veil which keeps Jewish peoples eyes blinded from seeing the Messiah, while at the same time the Tanach reveals Messiah? What is the King James suggesting? The Greek word for blinded(b) in king James really should be translated as "calloused" or hardened. By this corrected reading we then would understand that Jewish people's minds or hearts are NOT blinded because they read the Tanach (OT), but rather their hearts are hardened from not believing. The veil also represents a failure of not seeing the end of mosaic administration. Therefore unbelief which is the hardness of heart or mind is the cause for failing to see or accept the Messiah. If the Torah or Tanach really produced unbelief how then could any of us truly demonstrate the Messiah, who is revealed in about 95% of the Hebrew Scriptures? The point is we wouldn't be able too! The Tanach stimulates faith for any reader, but if a reader reads without believing what they read, they are faithless. How then can they see the Messiah? If they fail to believe the scriptures then they also fail at accepting the revelation of them, which speak clearly about the Messiah. This is the key issue to what Rav Sha'ul (Paul) is saying. Jewish people are NOT blinded because they read Tanach, they are hardened because they read in unbelief. Unbelief is the veil which blocks ones perspective of seeing the truth. But remember that some Jewish people's unbelief is only temporal(c) and is not forever. This was planed deliberately by G-d for humanities sake. (Click here

**צפיה** *Za'Faw (Watchman)*

Which Hebrew definition means: *to be a look out, or to spy out, to watch, or observe.*

### Hebraic Commentary

In Ezekiel we find the Hebrew word "Zafaw". Its description tells of a person who's specifically called by G-d to be his watchman (a). A watchman in those days was someone who stood a post upon the Walls of Yerusalaiyim (Jerusalem). He was to warn the inhabitation of any immediate danger. If there did ever appear to be any danger the watchman would then sound the Shofar (b) in a specific way (c). Like the literal figure and duty of the watchman, Ezekiel was also called to act for G-d in the same maner (d). Only his voice was to be like the Shofar sounding. He was NOT to blow the Shofar (trumpet) whenever he felt like it. He was only to speak when G-d said to speak, and at NO other time

### Netanyahu will bend on Palestinian state

Israel's defense minister said in an interview published today that he expects Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu to agree to the principle of Palestinian statehood — something the Israeli leader has balked at doing since taking office a month ago. Netanyahu is coming under increasing pressure from Washington to resume peacemaking with the Palestinians, a process designed ultimately to create a Palestinian state that would live alongside Israel peacefully within fixed borders. He has stepped back from his original plan to hold off on political negotiations while working with the Palestinians to improve their economy. But Netanyahu, who plans to visit the White House next month, has stopped short of endorsing a separate Palestinian state. In an interview with the Haaretz daily, Defense Minister Ehud Barak suggested that Netanyahu could relent. "I believe that during Netanyahu's visit to Washington, Israel must formulate how it intends to move forward, and that formula will not propose three states for eight peoples," Barak said. The prime minister's office would not comment. But an aide to the prime minister said a policy review was (Click for more
