While listening to well known radio commentator one day, who believed that the biblical feasts or that is Rosh ha Shannah (feast of trumpets) was only for our Jewish nation really caused me to share a bit about what's for Israel and what's not. For instance and for that matter, all biblical celebrations <sup>(1)</sup> are for anyone who is a follower of the Messiah and the G-d of Israel <sup>(2)</sup>. The feasts are NOT a Jewish nor a Gentile thing but they are a G-D thing! <sup>(3)</sup>. Anyone today can celebrate them because the substance or spiritual truth and teaching of them point one to the plan of G-d and our Messiah, especially those who are of Jewish origin. But to say that the feasts are Old Testament and belong only to Jewish people is absurdly WRONG! While we understand that Messiah Yeshua (Jesus) did fulfill the spring feasts <sup>(4a)</sup> we also understand that the fall feasts are yet to be fulfilled. The spring feast which clearly showed in type the life, sacrifice, death and resurrection of our Messiah also in turn supports the fall feast fulfillment. If the Messiah fulfilled his first program of feasts he is then destined to complete the rest of them. But was the.....

### A future Kingdom!

*In this month we come to our annual celebration of the feast of Sukkot (Tabernacles)<sup>(N)</sup>. While many biblical commentators have a difference of opinion when it comes to the return of the Messiah we safely can say from scripture that our Messiah is promised a literal earthly Kingdom, and that's what the feast of*

*Sukkot is all about! During our fall celebration we will follow what G-d said in the book of V'yikra <sup>(a)</sup>. We will hold and wave a palm branch <sup>(b)</sup> in all global directions and wave it upwards and downwards and will recite a Hebraic blessing thanking G-d for all of his many provisions <sup>(c)</sup>. We will then dwell for seven days in a hut like booth called a Suk'ka in accordance with what G-d said in the torah <sup>(d)</sup>. This is the only feast where it is command for us to be "REJOICEFUL" at this time <sup>(e)</sup>. While these are the outward demonstrations of our celebration our spiritual or scriptural ones teach us that one day our Messiah will have an earthy Kingdom which is represented by the (temporal symbol of our suk'ka's) which point out that one day the Messiah will establish his temporal Suk'ka or Millennial Kingdom which will run for a time period of 1,000yrs. <sup>(f)</sup> During this future time of Sukkot the worship of all nations which are left upon the earth will be required to come and celebrate this yearly event <sup>(g)</sup>. Sukkot is also reminiscent of the last harvest time in which in the near future our scattered children of Israel will be finally regathered and will be brought back to the land of Israel <sup>(h)</sup>. Sukkot also reminds us that while we are yet here sojourners our final designation is to dwell with our G-d and Messiah. For in his messianic Kingdom the She'kinah (Glory presents) of G-d will rest and fill the earth starting with Jerusalem. The curse of earth....*
