What did the Messiah mean when he said, "Va' hee ya'mey No'ach(For as in the Days of Noah), thus will be the boe'oh shel ben ha ahdam (Coming of the Son of man)"? From this particular chapter of Mattiyahu ⁽¹⁾ his talmadim (disciples) begin the chapter with two serious questions ⁽²⁾ which deal with (a) the second coming, or return of Messiah and (b) the end times ^(3a). In Yeshua (Jesus) powerful Sha'nan ^(3b) he then expounds on the breakdown of the end times, which we know is the tribulation period for our Jewish Nation and a rebellious world. ⁽⁴⁾ Which then brings us to a number of clusters ^(5a) of key points about preparedness, readiness, and watchfulness. ^(5b) The first piece of our cluster is our main focus here because it reveals the precise condition of man's heart during these times. The scripture says ⁽⁶⁾ that they were eating, drinking and marrying ⁽⁷⁾ Yeshua uses this Nohidic concept ⁽⁸⁾ in regards to what would happen to those not prepared or ready for his coming.
